AIR CANADA MEMBERS ACTIVE & RETIRED

TRAVEL PASSES

Dear Brothers & Sisters:

As you may have heard, the Flight Attendants' Union (CUPE) has filed a grievance concerning Air Canada's decision to provide B1 travel passes to the pilots.

CUPE's grievance is based on promises alleged to have been made by the Company to CUPE's Bargaining Committee in 2011 that the Company had no intention of giving to one group of employees superior travel benefits over another group.

The IAMAW is aware that its' retired and active Members have a significant interest in this issue. We have therefore been in discussions with CUPE and its legal counsel and have reached an agreement where CUPE will share information with the IAMAW and its counsel and that representatives of the IAMAW will attend the hearings into this matter. The hearings are currently scheduled to commence in November with further dates to the end of January 2018.

We will keep you posted as to further developments regarding this matter.
